Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS):

1. What songs or music activities do you enjoy the most in music class?
2. Can you show me a musical instrument you like playing with?
3. How does music make you feel? Can you describe it?
4. Is there a song or melody you've learned that you really like? What do you like about it?
5. What kind of music do you like to dance to?
6. Can you tell me about a musical story or character you've learned about recently?
7. Do you have any ideas for fun musical activities we could do in class?

Key Stage 1 (KS1):

1. What's your favourite musical game or activity in music lessons?
2. Can you show me a song you've learned to sing or play on an instrument?
3. How do you think music helps us express our feelings and emotions?
4. Is there a particular musical artist or composer you find inspiring? Why?
5. What musical skills are you working on improving in music class?
6. Do you have any ideas for a class music project or performance?
7. How does music make you feel more connected to others in your class?

Key Stage 2 (KS2):

1. Can you share an example of a piece of music you've composed or created recently?
2. What genre of music do you enjoy listening to outside of school?
3. How does music impact your mood and concentration when you're studying or doing homework?
4. Are there any musical instruments you'd like to learn to play in the future?
5. What are your thoughts on the music curriculum in our school? Is there anything you'd like to see added or changed?
6. Have you ever performed in a school concert or musical event? How did it make you feel?
7. If you could choose a piece of music to teach the class, what would it be and why?
